To whom it may concern

This letter is notice of the Conservator of Flora and Fauna's decision to enter the following trees to the ACT Provisional Tree Register under the provisions of the *Tree Protection Act 2005* (the Act).

**The registration consists of the following:**

RT1027-Group, located on section 57 Hughes and sections 66 and 78 Deakin  
5 x *Eucalyptus blakelyi* (Blakely's red gum).

You are receiving this notification as the trees are located close to your home.

The trees have been placed on the provisional register in recognition of their scientific value. These trees form part of an endangered Yellow Box – Red Gum woodland community, which provides important breeding habitat for regionally vulnerable species such as the Gang Gang cockatoo (*Callocephalon fimbriatum*). It is important to protect over mature hollow bearing trees, as the loss contributes to further deterioration of the endangered woodland community and associated ecology.

The decision to provisionally register a tree is non-appealable, however I would encourage lodgement of any additional information by parties who may be affected by a registration.

In accordance with Section 52(1) of the Act the Conservator will make a decision regarding full registration of the tree within a year of it being provisionally registered. This decision will take into consideration any submissions or other relevant information received within the 21-day period after notification and/or information subsequently requested.
