

Notice of 2020 RHR AGM

The Annual General Meeting of Red Hill Regenerators (Red Hill Bush Regenerators, **RHR**) will be held on Sunday 1 November at 11am on Red Hill Nature Reserve near the Mugga Way carpark near Francis Street.

At this meeting, a resolution will be voted on to make a number of changes to the RHR Rules. These changes are proposed in order to:

- Include a dispute resolution that is now required for all incorporated associations by the ACT government under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1991*.
- Match the constitution with our current operations including the simplification of the membership fee to a single per-person, lifetime fee of \$10.

A copy of the proposed new RHR Rules with the proposed changed sections highlighted will be made available on the RHR website before the AGM.
